#### ABOUT THE PROJECT

When Minneapolis-based HealthPartners was selecting furniture for a new clinic, designer Molly Ells was searching for a comfortable, accessible chair, but did not want predictable waiting room furniture. She was looking for something unique – a chair with a modern feel and an updated transitional look that also kept comfort and healthcare needs at the forefront.

Molly first saw the SitOnIt Seating chair at MenneComm, a day-long conference in Minneapolis that introduces new commercial products. "It was a chair I hadn't seen before," she remembers, and that was a huge selling point. She wanted to specify something unexpected, but also liked the fit, size and cost of the chair.

#### WHAT MADE THE DIFFERENCE?

The SitOnIt Seating Visit chair fit the modern feel Molly was looking for in the new HealthPartners clinic. She liked the seat, the updated transitional look, and the fact that the style didn't compromise the chair's fit for healthcare. "It was nice to see a chair that catered to healthcare needs – like coming with a cleanout – but looked modern," says Molly. The sit test is what really sealed the deal. The chair is a standout for comfort at its price point because making it easy to get in and out of was a priority in the design. They then coordinated the Visit chairs with occasional tables from the Mezzanine collection.

### WHAT'S NEXT

This large purchase points to great things for SitOnIt Seating in the healthcare market. While Health Partners doesn't standardize on seating, SitOnIt Seating has been well received for its look and feel. "It's the whole package," remarks Molly, "it looks good, feels good and works within our project timelines."
